Subj: Transfers and postings of Government servants.

\*\*\*\*\*

Government have noticed a tendency among Government servants to approach Ministers, M. Ps, M. L. As. and other influential and prominent public agencies/personalities to obtain support for cancellation or modification of orders of posting or transfer or for remaining in a particular region of the State.

2/- The canvassing of non-official or other outside influence is prohibited under Rule 20 of the M. P. Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1965 which reads as follows :-

" No Government servant shall bring or attempt to bring any political or other influence to bear upon any superior authority to further his interests in respect of matters pertaining to his service under the Government".

The instructions contained in para of this department's memo No. 1680-2375-I(iii) dated the 6th August 1959 are relevant in this connection.

3/- All Government servants should be cautioned that in future resort to such practices will be taken serious notice of and proceedings under the Madhya Pradesh Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal)

Rules may have to be started or a suitable note of such default made in the confidential personal file/character roll of the Government servant concerned. These instructions may please be brought to the notice of all Government servants serving under your control.
