Sub:- Seeking redress in courts of law by Government servants of grievances arising out of their employment or conditions of service.

Attention is invited to this department's confidential memo No. 1141-1463-I-(iii), dated 28th May, 1959 on the above subject in which it is, inter-alia, stated that when a Government servant wants to sue the Government in a court of law for redress of grievances arising out of service matters, he may be informed that such permission is not necessary and that if he decides to sue the Government, he may do so on his own responsibility. On reconsideration, it has been decided that, in such cases, it would be enough if the Government servant is informed that permission to sue the Government is not necessary, and it should not be added that 'if he decides to have recourse to a court of law, he may do so on his own responsibility.
