Sub :- Simplification of the methods of calculation
of leave salary.

According to Rule 17 of the M.P. Revised Leave Rules 1934 a Government Servant on earned leave is entitled to leave salary equal to the average of the actual monthly pay earned during the ten complete months immediately preceding the month in which the leave commences or the substantive pay to which the Government servant is entitled immediately before the commencement of leave, whichever is greater. Calculation of leave salary on the basis of average monthly pay is not, however, necessary in the case of those holding posts the maximum of whose pay scale does not exceed Rs. 600/-. As a further measure of simplification of accounting procedure, the State Government are pleased to decide that in modification of Rule 17 of the M.P. Revised Leave Rules-1934, all Government servants shall be entitled to leave salary equal to the pay drawn immediately before proceeding on earned leave.

2. These orders shall apply to all Government servants, who proceed on leave on or after 1st April, 1976.


