Sub:- Recovery from Government servants.

Because of inordinate delay in responding to communications issued by Government, considerable expenditure has to be incurred in reminding subordinate officers and in collecting information by issuing telegrams or on telephones and sometimes even by sending a messenger. Government take a serious view of this state of affairs. With a view to avoiding unnecessary expenditure as a result of carelessness and inefficiency on the part of subordinate officers, it has been decided that in case an officer fails to respond to communications from Government within a reasonable time and if telegraphic and/or telephonic reminders are required to be issued to him, Government would recover from him the cost of such telephonic and telegraphic reminders. In addition, such other punishments, as may be deemed necessary in the circumstances of the case may also be imposed after going through the necessary formalities.
