2. साथ ही शासन के ध्यान में यह तथ्य लाया गया है कि विभिन्न केन्द्रीय संस्थानों/विभागों में आरक्षित पदों पर चयनित प्रदेश के अनुसूचित जाति, अनुसूचित जनजाति एवं अन्य पिछड़ा वर्ग के व्यक्तियों के जाति प्रमाण पत्रों के सत्यापन हेतु भेजे गए प्रकरण कई वर्षों से लंबित हैं, जो इस संबंध में भारत सरकार द्वारा जारी निर्देशों एवं गाईडलाइन में उल्लेखित निर्धारित समयावधि का उल्लंघन है ।

3. यह स्पष्ट किया जाता है कि उक्त विषय के संबंध में भारत सरकार द्वारा समय-समय पर निर्देश जारी किए गए हैं, जिसमें जाति प्रमाण पत्र के सत्यापन की समय-सीमा एक माह निर्धारित है । भारत सरकार के पत्र क्रमांक 41034/1/2022-Estt. (Res-I), दिनांक 29 मार्च 2023 के अनुसार जाति प्रमाण पत्र का सत्यापन निर्धारित समयावधि एक माह में कर संबंधित नियुक्ति प्राधिकारी को भी सूचित किया जाना है । सुलभ संदर्भ हेतु परिपत्र की प्रति संलग्न प्रेषित है ।

I wish to draw your attention to the directives outlined by the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievance & Pension, Department of Personnel & Training, OM No.23/08/2005-AVD II dated May 25, 2005, and letter No.41034/4/2020-Estt(Res-I) dated March 19, 2021, concerning the timely verification of caste certificates for candidates seeking appointment against reserved quota of vacancies under the Central Government on the basis of SC/ST and OBC certificates.

2. In light of the aforementioned directives, I wish to bring to your notice that a substantial number of Constables have been appointed in the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) during the year 2022. The cases for the verification of Caste Certificates pertaining to those personnel who availed appointment on the basis of SC/ST/OBC Certificates have been forwarded to the respective District Magistrates/Civil Authorities of the State. Despite considerable lapse of time, a total of 47 cases (District-wise details of pending cases attached as Appendix-'A') are yet to be verified.

3. Similarly, in accordance with the mandatory service condition, the Character & Antecedents rolls of all newly recruited Constables have been dispatched to the concerned District Magistrates/Superintendents of Police for verification. However, as of the current date, a total of 13 cases of Character & Antecedents verification (district-wise details of pending cases attached as Appendix-'B') are still pending receipt from the concerned Civil Authorities.

4. In light of the above, I request your kind intervention in issuing suitable directives to all concerned District Magistrates, urging them to accord top priority to the matter pertaining to the verification of Caste Certificates and Character & Antecedents Rolls. It is imperative that the verification of these personnel be expedited and forwarded to the relevant CISF authorities at the earliest.

5. Further, it is also suggested that a 'Nodal Officer' at the state level may be nominated for monitoring and timely completion of Caste Certificate and C&A verification cases, please.

Subject:-Timely verification of Caste/Community Certificates - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Government of India has been issuing instructions to all the States/UT Government for streamlining the process of verification of Caste certificate and ensuring its timely completion.

2. In this regard, this Departments' letter No.41034/4/2020-Estt.(Res-I), dated 19.03.2021; addressed to the Chief Secretaries of all States/UTs and letter No.41034/2/2022-Estt.(Res-I), dated 21.10.2022, addressed to the Secretaries (General Administrative Departments) of all States/UTs may be referred vide which attention of all the States/ UT Governments was invited towards some cases of withholding of pensionary benefits of the employees of the Central Government belonging to ST category due to pendency of their caste verification process at the end of concerned State Government. The concern and the serious view taken by the Parliamentary Committee on the Welfare of SC and ST in this regard was also communicated to the State/ UT Governments vide the aforesaid letters. Copies of the aforesaid two letters are attached.

3. Now, the Parliamentary Committee on the Welfare of SC and ST, vide its recommendations in its 21st Report (17th Lok Sabha), has reiterated its earlier recommendations for timely completion of caste verification process.

4. The State/UT Governments have been requested from time to time that they are required to ensure at their own level that veracity of the Caste/Community certificate referred to the district authorities is verified and reported to the appointing authority **within one month** of receipt of request from such authority. The State/UT Governments are also required to initiate disciplinary proceedings against the officers of the State who default in timely verification of Caste Status.

5. In view of the above, all the State/ UT Governments are once again requested to ensure adherence to the aforesaid instructions and ensure that veracity of the Caste/Community certificate referred to the district authorities is verified and reported to the appointing authority **within one month** of receipt of request from such authority.

Subject: Timely verification of Caste/Community Certificates – regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that instances have come to the notice where the pensionary benefits of employees belonging to ST category, who were working in various offices and organizations under Central Government in the State of Tamil Nadu, have been withheld on the ground that their caste verification is pending from the State Government. The Parliamentary Standing Committee on the Welfare of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (SC&ST) have taken a serious view of this, and has directed this Department to issue necessary guidelines to all the concerned for ensuring timely verification of the Caste Certificate of the employees belonging to the reserved category.

2. It is stated that the responsibility for the issue and verification of Caste Certificate lies with the concerned State/UT Government. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide its Order dated 2.9.1994 in the matter of in the matter of *Kumari Madhuri Patil vs Addl. Commissioner*, has laid down the detailed guidelines for effective verification of the Caste Certificates of the employees, so that no person, on the basis of fake caste certificate, may secure employment wrongfully in the Government.

3. DoP&T has issued various guidelines from time to time for streamlining the process of verification of Caste Certificate of the employees, and has requested the State/UT Governments for timely verification of the same. However, as mentioned above, instances have come to notice that the appointing authority has taken an unduly long time in getting the caste status of an employee verified through the concerned State authorities which is totally in contravention of the existing instructions. In this regard, attention is invited towards the following instructions of DoPT in the matter:

- (i) DoPT OM No. 36019/7/1975-Estt (SCT) dated 31.10.1975 (copy at Annexure-I) provides that the candidates belonging to the SC/ST category have to produce a Certificate in the prescribed form issued by

one of the prescribed authorities in support of their claim of belonging to a SC/ST. Where such a candidate is unable to produce a Certificate from any of the prescribed authorities, he may be appointed provisionally on the basis of whatever prima facie proof he is able to produce in support of his claim subject to his furnishing the prescribed Certificate within a reasonable time, and if there is genuine difficulty in his obtaining a Certificate, the appointing authority should itself verify his claims through the District Magistrate concerned.

- (ii) DoPT OM No. 36011/16/80-Estt (SCT) dated 27.2.1981 (copy at Annexure-II) provides that the verification of caste status at every important upturn of employee's career is necessary, as an SC candidate may lose his status of SC if he embraces a religion other than Hinduism and Sikhism (DoPT OM No. 36011/3/2005-Estt (Res) dated 9.9.2005 provides that an SC candidate loses his SC status if he embraces a religion other than Hinduism, Sikhism or Buddhism).
- (iii) DoPT, vide letter No. 36022/1/2007 - Estt (Res) dated 20.3.2007 (copy at Annexure-III), have requested the State/UT Governments to issue instructions to the District Magistrates/District Collectors/Deputy Commissioners of the districts to the effect that they should ensure at their own level that veracity of the Caste/Community certificate referred to the district authorities is verified and reported to the appointing authority within one month of receipt of request from such authority. The State/UT Governments were also requested to initiate disciplinary proceedings against the officers who default in timely verification of Caste Status.
- (iv) DoPT, vide letter No. 41034/3/2012 - Estt (Res) dated 11.4.2012 (copy at Annexure-IV), have reiterated the above instructions dated 20.3.2007 requesting the State/UT Governments to issue instructions to the concerned district authorities to ensure veracity of the Caste/Community Certificate referred to them and report the same to the appointing authority within one month of receipt of request from such authority. This letter also conveys the directions of the Parliamentary Committee at that time on the Welfare of SCs and STs that the State/UT Governments may constitute a District-Level Committee in each District which may hold regular meetings to ensure timely verification of Caste Certificates.
- (v) DoPT OM No. 36011/1/2012-Estt (SCT) dated 8.10.2015 (copy at Annexure-V) reiterates the earlier instructions on timely and effective verification of the Caste Certificate so that the benefit of reservation and other scheme of concessions etc. go only to the rightful claimants.
- (vi) DoPT letter No. 36011/1/2012-Estt (SCT) dated 14.3.2016 (copy at Annexure-VI) addressed to all State/UT Government again reiterates the earlier instructions on verification of Caste Certificate within a reasonable time.

4. In view of the above, all State/UT Governments are again requested that the above-mentioned instructions may be brought to the notice of all

the concerned officers, and it may be ensured that the process of caste verification is completed within a reasonable time, and the concerned appointing authorities are informed about the veracity of the Caste Certificate of the candidates/employees within one month of the receipt of such request from the concerned appointing authority.
