In partial modification of the orders contained in the General Administration Department Memorandum No. 2341-3006-I-(iii)/64 dated the 11th December, 1964, the State Government have further been pleased to order that the ministerial Government servants (excluding contingency paid staff) if they are required to attend duty on all the **second Saturdays** of the month and their office hours are from 10.30 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. should be allowed sixteen days casual leave instead of thirteen days. The above orders would, however, not be applicable to the ministerial staff of the Press and of other departments who are governed by the Factories Act and Labour Laws.
