Subject:- Acceptance of resignation of a Government servant during the pendency of departmental enquiry.

....

1. A case has been brought to the notice of Government in which after holding a departmental enquiry against a Government servant, Government took a provisional decision for imposing a particular penalty and a show cause notice was issued to the delinquent officer. In the meantime, the delinquent officer submitted his resignation which was accepted, before the departmental enquiry case was decided finally. This action was not proper as it enabled the delinquent officer to escape punishment for his misdeeds by the acceptance of his resignation.

2. It is, therefore, requested that all appointing authorities under your control may be instructed to ensure that in future the resignation of a Government servant against whom a departmental enquiry is pending should not be accepted before the departmental enquiry case is finally decided.
