Sub :- Travel Concession to Government servants during regular leave.



Attention is invited to the Condition No. XIII of this department's memorandum referred to above. Queries have been received from certain quarters that, as upper and lower classes have been abolished in the buses plied by a nationalised public transport system like Madhya Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation and the difference remains only in types of buses viz. De-Luxe/Semi De-Luxe/Luxury and as such as to how the appropriate class of accommodation may be determined for purpose of leave travel concession.

Government have considered the above point carefully and are pleased to decide that Government servants drawing pay of Rs. 500/- p.m. and above only, are entitled to perform journeys by De-Luxe/Semi-De-Luxe/Luxury buses, while they perform journeys availing leave travel concession.
