Subject:- Recruitment Rules - Constitution of
Departmental Promotion Committee.

It has been brought to the notice of Government by the Public Service Commission that the personnel of the selection committee to consider the suitability of officers for promotion to higher posts has not been decided on a uniform basis and sometimes, even the Secretary to Government in the administrative department is not included in the Selection Committee. This does not appear to be desirable. Further, in respect of some of the posts e.g. those to which promotion will be from Class III to Class II and from Class II to Class I, the claims of a large number of persons will have to be considered every year. Except for the posts mentioned in the Appendix to the Madhya Pradesh Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1957, recruitment to all class II and class I posts are within the purview of the Commission. In such cases, the association of a Member of the Commission with the Departmental Promotion Committee will be of considerable advantage. The Commission would then have, through their Member on the Committee, the advantage of the views of other Members who may have more information about the quality of the candidates than is ordinarily available in the confidential reports of the officers concerned.

2. Government have accordingly decided that while constituting the Departmental Promotion Committee to consider the cases of promotions of officers to those services and posts which are within the purview of the Commission, the Chairman of the Commission or a Member of the Commission nominated by the Chairman should invariably be included to preside over such Departmental Promotion Committee. All Departments are requested to take action to amend the Recruitment Rules framed by them accordingly in case they have not done so.
